

Janet's career was launched in 1987 when she joined the development team at Carlow University as Director of Annual Fund after her graduation from the University as an adult student. Finding her niche in fundraising she moved to Director of Individual Giving at Pittsburgh Mercy Foundation before landing at Pitt as Director of Development for the School of Nursing. While at Pitt Janet worked with the Dean to secure the school's first endowed chair with a gift of \$1.5 million. In 2000 she joined Grove City College as Executive Director of Development where she oversaw the school's successful \$60 million capital campaign.



Janet went on to spend six years at the Vice President of Development and Executive Director of the Presbyterian SeniorCare Foundation before returning to higher education in the position of Advancement/Major Gifts Officer at Geneva College. Working in an organization that was close to her heart, Janet served as a development officer for the Pittsburgh Kids Foundation prior to joining Advancement Advisors. In addition to her fundraising responsibilities, she participated in the Foundation's ministries including, Haiti orphans, Youth Pastors, and Women's Ministry.



Throughout her career, Janet has been a strong proponent of professional education and training in the fundraising field. When looking back on her career she sees her role as a mentor to young professionals and her active involvement with the Association of Professional Fundraisers (AFP), including serving the organization as President from 1998-2000, as some of her proudest moments. She was recognized by her peers for her contributions to the field with the Outstanding Fundraising Executive Award in 2003.

She shared, "What I found most rewarding was being able to step in and really help organizations in a meaningful way.
